

1QR Ancient Greece and the Olympics

Hi class, in our lessons about ancient Greece we will be using some of these materials. You will use others to go deeper into the matters.

Your final task will be either to prepare an imaginary interview to a woman who lived in ancient Greece (10 questions and answers to be recorded or performed) or to prepare a Kahoot quiz (20 questions) to be played in class.

Each group will be asked to to introduce their project and to answer a few questions about it.

Assessment will be about:

Points	Topic	Checklist
5	Timing	Have I met the deadline?
10	Product	Is my project in the format the teacher asked for?
30	Content	Have I learnt some new information? How well? How deep have I learnt?
15	Performance	Have we, as a group, arranged a good presentation? Have we involved the audience? Reading notes is forbidden!!!
30	English language	Have I learnt and used some new vocabulary? Have I used correct grammar? Have I been fluent enough when speaking? How about my pronunciation?
5	Originality	Is my project my own creation or just a copy-and-paste work?
5	Sources	Have I quoted my sources?
